Mail and Courier Deliveries

The Ridge Sierra does not have regular mail services. However, courier deliveries for any arriving guests are accepted. If a parcel name does not match any future guest, the parcel will be refused. Automated Front Desk Services

For greater convenience we have a 24-hour automated Front Desk services. Through the Automated Front Desk, a member of the staff is available to you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Please feel free to contact the Front Desk by dialing "0" at anytime with any questions you may have during your stay.

Resort Staff

Housekeeping staff is available at the resort between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. daily. We provide room cleaning service prior to check-in as well as one midweek cleaning for each full week stay. Small amenities such as clean towels and soap are available upon request by contacting the Front Desk. After hours, you may also find amenities behind the desk in the lobby, free for you to use.

Maintenance staff is available at the resort from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. To request maintenance assistance, dial "0" on your unit phone.

For after-hours emergencies, contact the Front Desk by hitting "0" on your phone.

Check Out Times

Individual units have different check-out times. The check-out times are posted behind your unit's entry door. Check-out times are scheduled so that our cleaning personnel may prepare the unit for the next member or guest checking-in.

Late check-out are possible based on the unit and availability. Please check with the Front Desk in advance to request a late check-out.

Occupancy Limit

Overnight occupancy per unit is limited to six persons (including children). These limits are mandated by Fire Regulations, local Development Codes and Resort Club rules and are strictly enforced at all times.

Parking/Overflow Parking

The Ridge Sierra Resort parking is unassigned. You are allowed to park anywhere you see a "Tahoe Village Homeowners Association" sign. Spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please make sure the parking pass you received upon checkin is clearly visible on your car's dashboard so we know that the car belongs to one of our guests. Observe all restricted parking areas such as Handicapped Parking and fire hydrants to avoid having your vehicle towed.

Overflow parking is located at Galaxy Lane. If you arrive with a boat or RV, it will need to be parked in the overflow parking area. Please be sure to contact the Tahoe Village Homeowners Association at (775) 588-7820.



The Ridge Sierra is part of the Tahoe Village Homeowners Association. As mentioned above, if you have a boat or recreational vehicle it will need to parked in the over flow parking lot located on Galaxy Lane. You will need to contact the Tahoe Village Homeowners Association and arrange it with them. You may contact their office at (775) 588-7820. They are open Monday-Friday 8:30am-5:00pm. All of our guests are

welcome to use the pool that is located on Olympic Court which is right by their office at 321 Olympic Court Stateline NV 89449. The code to access the pool is 2580#. You are also able to see the code on channel 13.

Express Computer Center

A computer and printer are available in the resort lobby 24 hours a day. Guests are invited to use the computer to check email, print boarding passes or visit some of the useful websites listed in this guide for updates on local events and information.

Laundry

Each room is equipped with a washer and dryer located in the hallway bathroom. The Resort provides two complimentary boxes of laundry detergent.

Air Conditioning

The rooms at Ridge Sierra are not equipped with air conditioning. Portable fans are located within the hall closet of each unit for your use as needed.

Snow Removal

The resort staff will do snow removal on property when it is more than 3 inches deep. We will also need to remove the snow on your balcony; in which case we will need to enter the unit to do this and ask that you do not place the "Do not Disturb" sign on your door.

Unfortunately, resort staff is not responsible for removing your vehicle should it become stuck in the snow. We provide snow shovels in each unit to assist with your personal snow removal needs. You are welcome to ask our staff if they are available to assist you, but we can not guarantee staff availability as they may be busy with site snow removal for the safety of all our guests.

Ice melt is available from maintenance staff during business hours. After hours, ice melt is kept behind the Front Desk for your use.

Our Pet Policy

Please bring your furry friends! The Ridge Sierra offers special PET-FRIENDLY rooms and is happy to welcome your furriest family member. We ask only that you let us know in advance; and that your pet(s) are well-behaved, so they don't cause a disturbance for other guests or damage resort property.

Microwave Oven and Convection Cooking Instructions

Microwave Cooking

- 1. Press PROGRAM
- 2. Enter the desired cooking time using the digital touch pad
- 3. Press POWER LEVEL pad to change the power level, if desired
- 4. Press START/PAUSE pad to begin cooking cycle
- 5. A tone will sound and the oven will shut down at the end of the cooking cycle.

Convection Cooking

- 1. Press CONV COOK under Convection
- 2. Adjust temperature settings as desired using the MORE or LESS touch pads
- 3. Press **START/PAUSE** pad. **PREHEAT** displays with the selected temperature and **PLACE FOOD on RACK** displays when the oven is pre-heated
- Open oven door, place food on rack. When you close the oven door ENTER COOKING TIME displays
- 5. Enter desired cooking time using the digital touch pad
- 6. Press the **START/PAUSE** pad to begin the cooking cycle
- 7. A tone will sound and the oven will automatically turn off at the end of the cooking cycle.

Fireplace Instructions

Lighting Instructions

- 1. Turn the key to the left to turn on the gas
- 2. Use one of the long match sticks located on the mantle to ignite the gas
- 3. WHEN IN DOUBT ABOUT IGNITING THE FIREPLACE, PLEASE DIAL "0" TO REACH THE FRONT DESK FOR ASSISTANCE.

To Turn the Gas Off in the Fireplace

Turn the key to the right and that will turn off the gas to the fireplace.
