To reach the front desk, please dial "0" from your unit phone.

**CHECKOUT TIME**: Please note check-out time with the front desk. Please help us by checking out on time. Check-out times are strictly enforced. If you leave prior to normal check out day, please contact the front desk. Thank you for your cooperation.

**PET POLICY**: For the comfort of all owners/guests of the Thunderbird, pets are **NOT** allowed on the property at any time, regardless of size or breed. Only accredited service animals are allowed providing appropriate documentation has been provided to staff in advance. If you are turned in for having a pet(s) on property and cannot provide appropriate documentation, you will be assessed a \$250.00 fine for the offense and asked to board your pet(s) immediately. The Thunderbird Resort Club Board of Directors along with QM Resorts staff understands that pets are family too; however, we ask that they not be housed at the resort. If you would like a list of available pet boarding locations in Reno/Sparks, please contact our front desk by dialing "0" from your unit phone. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

**PARKING**: Parking passes are provided at time of check-in. They provide your assigned unit, check-out time, as well as the check-out date and map of the resort. Please keep your parking pass on the dash of your vehicle. Any vehicles found without a parking pass will be towed at your expense.

**PERSONAL ITEMS/LOST & FOUND**: The resort is not responsible for any personal items left in the rooms. However, if items are found, they will be held on property for 24 hours. If no contact is made within 24 hours, the item(s) will be moved to an offsite holding area for up to 30 days, and then discarded if left unclaimed.

#### **Mail and Courier Deliveries**

For regular mail deliveries, please use the address above, including unit number.

We do not have regular mail pick-up. However, a drop box is located across the street at the front desk of the Victorian RV Park. The RV Park's front desk is open from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. daily. They are closed on major holidays.



# **Automated Front Desk Services**

For greater convenience we have 24 hour automated front desk services.

Through the Automated Front Desk, a member of the front desk staff is available to you 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Please feel free to contact the front desk by dialing "0" from your unit phone at anytime with any questions you may have during your stay.

# **Resort Staff**

**Housekeeping staff** is available at the resort between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:35 p.m Everyday. We provide room cleaning service prior to check-in as well as one midweek cleaning for each five day stay. Small amenities such as clean towels and soap are available on request through the front desk. Simply dial "0" on your unit phone.

**Maintenance staff** is available at the resort from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. everyday. To request maintenance assistance, use the maintenance button on you unit phone, or dial "0." In the event of an after-hour maintenance emergency, contact the front desk first. In extreme emergencies, maintenance will be dispatched immediately. In non-emergency situations, prompt, nextday maintenance response will be scheduled.

For any after-hours emergencies, contact the front desk and they will find staff to assist you.

# **Resort Information**

#### **Security Gates**

Your room keys allow you to gain access into the resort 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

If you happen to misplace or forget your room key, contact a front desk agent who will screen you for your room number and last name.

If you are expecting visitors, make sure they are prepared to provide your room number and last name to our front desk. With the correct information, our friendly front desk agent will allow them through the gate.

# Parking

Resort parking is unassigned however spaces should be available near your unit. Please make sure the parking pass you received upon check-in is kept visible on your car's dash board so we know the car belongs to a guest. Please observe restricted areas such as handicapped parking and fire hydrants to avoid having your vehicle towed.

For larger recreational vehicle parking, please contact the front desk so that we may find you an area to park.

# Ice Machine and Drinks Machine

An ice machine and soft drink vending machine are located near the hot tub area between the resort lobby and presentation theater. As a courtesy to our other guests, please do not use the resort's ice machine to fill coolers and ice chests. Bags of ice are available for purchase across the street at the Victorian RV Park.

# Laundry

The laundry facility is also located in the recreation center building. There is no charge for use of the laundry machines, however the Resort does not provide any laundry detergent. For your convenience a coin-operated detergent dispenser is available in the laundry room.

Laundry Room hours are 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily.

# **Transportation**

For information about local taxi service, please contact the front desk.

An RTC bus stop is located directly outside the resort gates. We are on Route 21 which takes you to the downtown Sparks terminal. From there you may transfer to Route 11 for service to downtown Reno. For a complete RTC bus schedule, please contact the front desk.

# Heated Pool, Spa, Courtyard Barbeque Area



Our heated pool and eight-person spa is open daily from 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. Use your room key for access to the pool area. Towels are available at the pool side. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult.

The Barbeques in the gazebo area are gas operated and are available for your use on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you would like to reserve the gazebo area for a special event, please make arrangements with our Concierge.



#### Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi is available in your room free of charge. There will be a required access code to utilize the service which may be collected at check in or by contacting your Front Desk Staff.

- Make sure you are connected to the Wireless Network "Thunderbird Resort".
- Click your internet Icon and the Hotel Internet Services Page will show on your window.
- Simply enter the current access code you received from the Front Desk Attendant into the correct access code line.

You will also have the option to upgrade your connection speed by purchasing additional bandwidth for \$4.99/1 day, \$9.99/3 days or \$19.99/week. Just select the Premium option on the log in screen.

#### Voicemail

To access your voicemail press the blinking button and follow the prompts:

Press 7 To play or replay messages

Press 5 To keep the message

Press 3 To delete the message

#### **Occupancy Limit**

Overnight occupancy, including children, is limited to four persons in a one-bedroom unit, and six persons in a two-bedroom unit. Because these limits are mandated by fire regulations, local codes and Resort Club rules, they are strictly enforced at all times.

#### **Check Out**

Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. Check-out times are scheduled so that our cleaning personnel may prepare the unit for the next member checking-in. Late check-out is possible based on availability. Please check with the front desk in advance to request a late check-out.

When you are ready to check out, please visit the front desk. In your unit, please make sure all the dishes, post, pans, etc. are clean and returned to their storage place (or placed in the dishwasher and turned on). Bedding does not need to be stripped. Towels should be placed on the floor or in the tub.



#### **Pet Policy**

For the convenience and comfort of all our guests, PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED on the property unless they are accredited service animals and the proper documentation is provided to staff in advance of check-in. There is a \$150 to \$250 cleaning fee if a pet is found on property.
